**1. Introduction**

- 1.1 The National Kidney Foundation (“**NKF**”) wishes to invite vendor (the “**Vendor**”) for the Term Contract for Pest Control Services at NKF premises.
- 1.2 This Invitation to Quote incorporates the following documents:

**2. Requirement Specifications**

- 2.1 The **Services** shall conform to the detail requirement specifications in **Annex B**.
- 2.2 The Vendor shall provide the Services over a period of **thirty-six (36) months, from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2027** with NKF having an option to extend for another twenty-four (24) months at the same terms and conditions.

**3. Eligibility criteria**

- 3.1 BCA Contractor’s registration under FM04 workhead - Pest Control with financial grade of L3 or above.

**4. Liquidated Damages**

- 4.1 Liquidated Damages shall be imposed should Vendor fails to comply with the requirements as stated in **Annex C**.

**5. Contractual Period**

- 5.1 The Vendor shall provide the Services over a period of **thirty-six (36) months, from 1 January 2025 to 31 December 2027** subject to such extension of the period of appointment by NKF.
- 5.2 Unless otherwise stipulated by NKF, the Services provided during the extended period of this Contract shall be subject to the terms and conditions hereof (as may be amended, varied, supplemented and/or replaced from time to time), and the Services provided during such extended period shall be deemed to be Services as defined in this Contract.

The proposals are to be delivered in a sealed envelope which is not to bear any mark of identification of the Vendor (defined in the Conditions of Contract). All submissions must be received by NKF before **7 June 2024, Friday, 3pm** (the “**Closing Date**”). Any submission received after the Closing Date will not be considered by NKF.

- v) **Past 5 Years and current track records**
- vi) **Extract of company/business registration from the Accounting & Corporate Regulatory Authority (ACRA), showing a full list of directors/partners of the Vendor (ACRA should not be more than 3 months from the point of submission);**
- vii) **Latest audited financial report or published accounts**

7.3 The submitted quotation shall be irrevocable and open for acceptance by NKF for **180 days** from the Closing Date. ## **8. Terms and Conditions**

- 8.1 The Terms and Conditions as set out in the Conditions of Contract shall form part of the binding contract between the successful Vendor and NKF. The Vendor shall perform the Services according to the requirements specified in **Annex A to D**.
- 8.2 NKF is not obliged to accept and reserves the right to reject the lowest or any quotation bid, or part or all of any quotation bid or assign any reason for rejecting any quotation bid. NKF reserves the right in the exercise of its absolute discretion to accept any part or all of any quotation bid.
- 8.3 Any additional new location/ site will be subjected to the same monthly servicing rate in terms of the nature of site (Dialysis Centre/ Building/ Store) throughout the contractual period inclusive of the option to extend period.

## **9 Price Quotations**

- 9.1 All prices quoted by the Vendor shall be in the lawful currency of the Republic of Singapore and exclusive of GST.
- 9.2 All prices quoted by the Vendor shall represent the total cost to NKF.

## **10. Employment of Qualified and Licensed Personnel**

- 10.1 The Vendor shall ensure that no unlicensed vector control technicians or uncertified vector control workers shall be employed by him or any sub-contractor, in the execution of any part of the works. The Contractor shall note that the employment of any unlicensed/uncertified vector control technician/workers is a breach of the Control of Vectors and Pesticides Act, Chapter 59 (CVPA).
- 10.2 The Contractor shall engage supervisors and technicians on a full-time basis to ensure the efficient execution of the works to the satisfaction of NKF. They shall also carry out all instructions/directions issued by NKF. and such instructions/directions shall be deemed to be instructions/directions given to the Contractor.
- 10.3 The Contractor shall submit a list of names and NRIC/FIN numbers of all the technicians and workers to be deployed by him under the Contract before the commencement of the contract and shall ensure that only such licensed technicians and certified workers be deployed for all works carried out under the Contract. The Contractor shall notify the NKF in writing, seven (7) days in advance of his intention to replace any qualified technician and worker deployed for the works.

## **11. Applicable Law**

- 11.1 A person who is not a party to this Invitation to Quote shall have no right under the Contracts (Rights of Third Parties) Act (Cap 53B) to enforce any of the terms herein.
- 11.2 This Invitation to Quote is subject to the Laws of Singapore and only the courts in Singapore shall have jurisdiction in respect of any disputes in relation to, in connection with or arising out of this Contract.

**(A) External Pavement, Driveway, Car park, Landscape Garden and Refuse Compactor Areas (HQ and IRC)**

To render the following control and treatment services **WEEKLY**:

- a. Spraying of manhole and sewerage system for cockroaches and other crawling insects control.
- b. Thermal machine spraying for control of ants and other garden and other insects.
- c. Spraying of entire drainage system for control of cockroaches and other insects.
- d. Outdoor baiting along perimeter for rodent control (weekly service).
- e. Spraying along perimeter of walls and columns for control of ants movements.
- f. Mosquito control including inspection to detect mosquito breeding sources for treatment (weekly service).
- g. Power spraying and fogging on major fly harborage areas i.e. compactor docks, loading docks etc for control of flies.
- h. Treatment to electrical equipment rooms, storerooms and plant rooms.
- i. Identify and destroy other pest harborage and breeding sources i.e. flies, ants nests, etc.
- j. Other pest control measures and treatment deem necessary for ensuring a pest-free environment.

**(B) Common areas, toilets, stores, equipment rooms, including roof**

To render the following control and treatment services **MONTHLY**:

- a. Adequate control against cockroaches, ants and crawling insects.
- b. Treatment shall primarily be spraying, dusting and baiting depending on circumstances.
- c. Mosquito control including inspection to detect mosquito breeding sources for treatment (weekly service).
- d. Rodent control to be effected in stores, plant rooms, lift pits, electrical closets and any other areas where there are signs of rat infestation.
- e. Other control and treatment measures deem to be necessary for keeping a pest free environment in the area involved.

**2. Premise Mapping**

The Vendor shall submit a premise mapping upon every scheduled service with the inspection checklist which clearly marks out:

- b) Cockroach sighting and locations of preventive/ eradication treatment. Indication of chemical utilized (Brand/ Product Name/ Pyrethroid Type) for treatment process is mandatory upon each service.
- c) Mosquito pupal/ larval sighting. Indication of chemical utilized (Brand/ Product Name/ Pyrethroid Type) for treatment process is mandatory upon each service.
- d) Photos showing building defects, evident of irregularities with location indicated.
- e) Any other pest activities observed and treatment rendered.

**3. Performance Requirements**

The Vendor shall conduct pest management program in a professional manner. There shall not be any feedback of pest sighting and/or infestation from tenants, public or any appearance in any media. Failing which, the Vendor shall, at their own cost, execute an intensive pest control program to eliminate any pest infestation immediately as per NKF's or NEA's requirement unless such pest infestation was highlighted for further action during their maintenance routine.

#### 4. Detailed Scope of Works for Rodents/ Cockroaches/ Subterranean Termites

Phase	Rodents*
Full Premise Inspection Service Requirement	<p>Carry out a baseline survey to identify the state of rodent infestation, signs of rodent infestation e.g. droppings, rub marks, gnaw marks, live rodents etc. and environmental irregularities/lapses that contributed to the infestation. The following should be carried out:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Inspect all accessible areas within the premises</li> <li>Inspect wash areas, refuse collection point(s), bin centre(s)/compound(s), if applicable</li> <li>Identify and record all signs of rodent infestation within the premises</li> <li>Gather information of signs of rodent activity from stakeholders</li> <li>Identify irregularities detected in housekeeping, storage and waste disposal that are contributing to rodent infestation and make recommendations of rectification /follow-up action.</li> <li>Identify potential rodent entry points and make recommendations for rectification/follow-up action</li> <li>Use of special equipment e.g. night vision infrared camera and borescope to verify status of infestation in inaccessible areas e.g. confined ceiling space and outdoor burrows</li> <li>Carry out any other forms of rodent surveillance, where necessary.</li> </ol>

## 5. Half-yearly Meeting

The Vendor shall arrange half-yearly meetings if needed with the respective Manager and Executives to discuss cleaning matters, works programme, performance standards, etc.

The Vendor shall be represented by senior personnel at management level. The Vendor shall be required to submit the minutes of meeting to NKF within two (2) weeks after the meeting.

**6. Reporting Checklist:**

- a. The Vendor shall submit a report following every treatment on each scheduled visit, giving a description of the work carried out and reporting any signs of pest infestation, number of rodents caught or killed etc.
- b. A checklist for every inspection carried out for the pest control operation shall be included in the Report.

**7. Ad-hoc Deployment of Pest Control Services:**

NKF reserves the absolute right of discretion to deploy, as and when the need arises, and on an ad-hoc basis, any of the Pest Control Service at any location(s) and time, at no additional cost to NKF during the Period of Contract.

The period of time commencing when the report of feedback / complaint is received and the time when qualified maintenance personnel arrives at the site to attend to the service call shall not exceed 4 hours.

**8. Pesticides / Safety Data Sheets**

Upon taking over the service site(s), the Contractor shall select and decide on the appropriate type of pesticides to be used for all treatment/maintenance aspects and provide updated Safety Data Sheets (SDS) for all pesticides proposed to be used for NKF's premises pest control service.

Should there be a change of pesticides used during the contract period, the Contractor shall submit new updated SDS for new selection of pesticides to NKF.

The Contractor shall also take the initiative to update NKF with new and updated SDS should the existing SDS becomes invalid.

The pesticides used shall comply with the regulations under Section 7 of the Control of Vectors and Pesticides Act (Chapter 59), and apply these according to the label instructions.
