Note:

- Vendors shall review the requirements specification carefully before submitting pricing and refer to Annex C – NKF Statistics for licence and user group onboarding assumptions.
- All prices are to be quoted in Singapore dollars.
- All itemised costs shall exclude GST.
- The SR standard man-days shall be consumed anytime during the Contract.
- The vendor shall provide the cost breakdown of the respective subscription (e.g., license fee, support and maintenance fee, etc.).
- If the vendor proposes any other software (including third-party software), the vendor shall indicate the cost itemised in the table above. Justification should be provided in the proposal for needing the license, whether it is mandatory or optional.
- Upon exercising the option for the Professional Service / Change Request (CR), the NKF will issue a PO based on the agreed contractor's CR effort (man-day cost) by multiplying the unit price (S\$).
- For optional items (e.g., Foxit), NKF will review the proposed implementation and maintenance approach before deciding whether to proceed.
- Training shall be aligned with NKF workflows and reflect the latest approved system configuration and setup. The training materials or documentation shall be provided for review 2 weeks before the session. It shall include one session for Administrators and three sessions for general users, with each session accommodating up to 20 participants.
- As an alternative option, vendors may propose a Policy Management Solution built on the same application platform as the Contract Management Solution. In such cases, the vendor shall provide a separate cost proposal and demonstrate how the solution will maintain logical separation between the two functions, including distinct user interfaces, branding, record repositories, administration, security controls, and search capabilities to prevent access across the respective registries.
